## **Series of job fairs aim to put area unemployed back to work**

*Fairs will focus on re-employment in Louisville area*

**FRANKFORT, Ky. (March 3, 2010)** – In response to high unemployment levels across the state and in the Louisville area, the Louisville Office of Employment and Training (OET), a partner in the KentuckianaWorks One Stop, will present a series of free job/resource fairs in conjunction with the Higher Income Requires Education Forum (HIRE), an affiliate of Greater Louisville Inc.

“During this time of record unemployment, we must do all we can to help out-of-work Kentuckians get back on the job so they can keep a roof over their heads, pay their bills and feed their families,” said Gov.
